

Survey Track

Surveyors are responsible to ensure project components are built to the correct dimensions in the correct location. They ensure that the information provided by both the owner and the designer is correct and that the existing conditions match that which is shown in the project documents. With their knowledge of the latest surveying equipment and techniques they are part field management and part quality control. Individuals that start within this track may also move to the field supervision, project management or estimating tracks.

Assistant Surveyor/Rodman

Responsibilities including but not limited to:

- Actively involved in project safety programs
- Assist surveyor as needed with project layout
- Verify Calculations
- Verify plan locations and dimensions

Surveyor

Responsibilities including but not limited to:

- Actively involved in project safety programs
- Responsible for the layout and survey on one or multiple projects
- Provide line and grade as required for crews
- Provide surveys for planning and payment calculation purposes
- Work with site supervision to determine the most beneficial layout for the work

Lead Surveyor

Responsibilities including but not limited to:

- Actively involved in project safety programs
- Responsible for layout on a large project or group of projects
- Direct the work of other surveyors on the project
- Provide line and grade as required for crews
- Provide surveys for planning and payment calculation purposes
- Work with site supervision to determine the most beneficial layout for the work
- Verify as-built conditions and report to project supervision

Survey Manager

Responsibilities including but not limited to:

- Oversee all survey requirements for the company
- Provide actual project surveying and layout when required
- Oversee the assignment and development of other surveyors within the company
- Ensure the company survey equipment is up to date and maintained
- Research new survey technologies that may be beneficial to the company
