# QC Track

Quality Control professionals ensure that the job is done right the first time. Their efforts not only help to eliminate rework but also to ensure the owner is satisfied. They will have experience in the inspection and testing of various construction disciplines like concrete, soils, welding, or maintenance of traffic. They will assist the project management and field operation teams with specification compliance as well as represent the company with the owner's inspectors. Individuals that start within this track may also move to the project management, field supervision, or estimating tracks.

## QC Technician

Responsibilities including but not limited to:

- Actively involved in project safety programs
- Assist Project QC Staff and Project Supervision
- Assist with field testing and documentation
- Work towards obtaining testing certifications

## QC Engineer

Responsibilities including but not limited to:

- Actively involved in project safety programs
- Assist QC Manager and/or other project management
- Responsible for field testing, i.e. concrete testing
- May be responsible for Maintenance of Traffic on a project
- Maintain required testing certifications

## Assistant QC Manager

Responsibilities including but not limited to:

- Actively involved in project safety programs
- Assist the QC manager or Project Manager
- Oversee assigned QC engineers and technicians
- Perform the duties of QC engineer as required

## QC Manager

Responsibilities including but not limited to:

- Actively involved in project safety programs
- Oversee QC on one or multiple projects
- Develop QC procedures for assigned project or projects
- Ensure company QC procedures are being followed
- Oversee assigned QC staff
- Perform the duties of QC engineer as required
- Research and manage any ISO or LEED certification initiatives
